Assessment

A clear and consistent opinion (teenagers do place too much importance on what they wear) is developed with sufficient specific supporting details (they spend too much money; they take too long to get ready; they feel "ugly" if they don't have name brand clothing).

Specific details and examples develop the argument: (pants and shirts and maybe a sweater can cost over 200\$; they can get the same material and quality of pants somewhere else for 20\$). The organization is logical.

There is a clear introduction, body and conclusion. Ideas are clustered into paragraphs. Each paragraph includes a clear topic sentence and details that develop it.

Strategies for the Series of Paragraphs

- Read the topic question and decide what position you will take in your response.
- Clearly state your opinion at the beginning and end of your response.
- Make it like a mini-essay. Include an introduction, explanation of reasons, and a conclusion.
- Support your opinion with reasons and relevant examples or facts. Pretend that you are like a lawyer presenting a case and supporting it with arguments.
- Make sure the divisions between paragraphs are clear.
